



Liberty 24-Hour Bait Shop Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: How do I get started, if I decided to buy a machine?

A: First, we decide how you want the machine configured; we will set the machine up to best fit your needs. Then you chose your graphics. Finally, we submit our purchase order to the factory and the machine is built.

Q: If it's going to be a cash deal, how much do you need down?

A: \$1800.00

Q: If I am approved for financing, how does that work?

A: The finance company will FedEx all your paperwork, you simply sign and return the required documents. Once the finance company receives paperwork, the machine will be shipped.

Q: What type of services does your company offer?

A: We are the only distributor for the 24 Hour Bait Shops we also are the parts supplier for the machines and other style bait machines. We offer 24/7 tech support for the bait machines. We also carry a large variety of cups and supplies for the bait machine. We are dedicated to helping our customers be successful in the bait vending business.

Q: What is the product capacity of the old used machines, versus the new machines?

A: The old style machines holds 150 units, while our Liberty 24 Hour Bait Shops will hold up to 400.

Q: What are the dimensions of the machine?

A: The Liberty is 39" W X 72" H X 36" D

Q: How much does the machine weigh?

A: 750 LBS (340kg)

Q: How much manpower do I need to move the machine?

A: At least 2 men and a appliance dolly

Q: How much change is needed to operated the machine?

A: 2 rolls each of .25 .05 & .10s.

Q: What type of electrical power do I need?

A: 7amps@115 (805 watts)

Q: How do I handle a machine malfunction if it's not covered in the manual?

A: Call us right away, if we don't have the answer the factory will.

Q: How often do you rotate the stock?

A: This depends on sales volume. We do ours once a week in the slow season and twice or more in the busy season.

Q: How long do some of your baits last?

A: Worms – 1 month
 Mealworms – 1 month
 Minnows- 7 days
 Wax Worms- 14 days
 Butter worms- 2 to 3 month
 Maggots- 14 days, but must be kept very cold
 Spikes are the same as maggots

Q: Can the machine operate outside all year?

A: Yes.

Q: What is a fairly reasonable time frame before a machine would pay for itself?

A: This depends on the location. We hope to have ours paid in the first year. Some locations may take 2 years

Q: How secure is the Liberty against vandalism?

A: There are anti- vandal panels on each side of the machine. This prevents someone from prying the door open. Also there is a locking cover that goes over the T handle lock. The clear front has triple-pane heated glass and protected by a layer of durable polycarbonate. Also we offer as an option a factory installed vending alarm security system.

Q: What type of warranty comes with the Liberty?

A: The Liberty comes with a three-year warranty on the electronic board, sensor boards, and refrigeration system. All other parts are warranted for one year with the exception of fluorescent bulbs, glass and paint finish.
